- 2. Licenses and Certifications; KSU Policies.** Vendor certifies that Vendor has all the certifications and licenses required, if any, to perform the Services outlined in this Agreement and further agrees to abide by all KSU policies and procedures. This Agreement is subject to all applicable KSU policies.
- 3. No Endorsement; No Partnership or Joint Venture.** This Agreement shall not be construed or represented as an endorsement by KSU of Vendor or Vendor’s goods or services. This Agreement does not constitute and shall not be construed as constituting a partnership or joint venture between the parties, and the parties shall be treated as independent contractors in all respects.
- 4. Termination.** KSU may terminate this Agreement at its sole discretion and for any reason.
- 5. Indemnification and Hold Harmless.** Vendor agrees to indemnify and hold harmless Board of Regents of the University System of Georgia and Kennesaw State University and their respective directors/trustees, officers, employees, and agents for every expense, liability, or payment by reason of any damage, or injury (including death) to persons or property suffered or claimed to have been suffered through any act or omission of Vendor or its agents or anyone directly or indirectly employed by Vendor arising in any way from the work called for by this Agreement.
- 6. Governing Law and Jurisdiction.** This Agreement shall be governed by the laws of the State of Georgia. The parties agree to the exclusive jurisdiction of the courts of Cobb County, Georgia, or the United States District Court for the Northern District of Georgia in Atlanta, Georgia in all questions and controversies arising out of this Agreement.
- 7. Entire Agreement, Modification, Assignment.** This Agreement, and any exhibits specifically incorporated herein by reference, constitute the entire agreement between the parties with respect to the subject matter. Any modification to this Agreement must be made in writing and signed by all parties. This Agreement is specific to the Parties, and may not be assigned or sublicensed by Vendor without the prior written permission of KSU.
